#11 - The Seven Last Plagues

Memory Verse - **Hand Out Scriptures to read**

Revelation 15:4 (NKJV) *Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested.”*

The Meaning of the Seven Last Plagues

How are the Egyptian plagues, considered the backdrop for the seven last plagues, instructive regarding their purpose and meaning?

What does the statement that “no man was able to enter the temple” (Rev. 15:8) suggest about the timing of the seven last plagues?

Revelation 14:10 (NKJV) *he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out full strength into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.*

Wrath? Compounded

Luke 21:23 (NKJV) *But woe to those who are pregnant and to those who are nursing babies in those days! For there will be great distress in the land and wrath upon this people.*

Matthew 23:35–36 (NKJV) *that on you may come all the righteous blood shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar. ³⁶ Assuredly, I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation.*

Romans 2:5–9 (NKJV) *But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, ⁶ who “will render to each one according to his deeds”: ⁷ eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality; ⁸ but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness—indignation and wrath, ⁹ tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek;*

Psalm 78:49–50 (NKJV) *He cast on them the fierceness of His anger, Wrath, indignation, and trouble, By sending angels of destruction among them. ⁵⁰ He made a path for His anger; He did not spare their soul from death, But gave their life over to the plague,*

The Outpouring of the Last Plagues

Deuteronomy 28:35 (NKJV) *The Lord will strike you in the knees and on the legs with severe boils which cannot be healed, and from the sole of your foot to the top of your head.*

Psalm 78:44 (NKJV) *Turned their rivers into blood, And their streams, that they could not drink.*

Joel 1:20 (NKJV) *The beasts of the field also cry out to You, For the water brooks are dried up, And fire has devoured the open pastures.*
